### **2. Timeliness:**

- In case you cannot complete the review within the stipulated timeframe please notify the editorial office. Timely reviews are essential for maintaining the efficiency of the publication process.

### **3. Comprehensive Review:**

- Evaluate the manuscript thoroughly, including methodology, analysis, results, and conclusions. Please provide constructive comments on the strengths and weaknesses of each section.
- Evaluate the study design, experimental procedures, and data analysis. Assess whether the methodology is thorough and suitable for addressing the research question.
- Verify the appropriateness of statistical methods used.
- Check the legibility and clarity of graphics and tables used.
- Specify any major or minor revisions needed for improvement. Your comments will help authors to enhance the quality of their work.

### **4. Originality and References:**

- Ensure that the manuscript presents original research and does not contain significant portions of text from previously published works. Report any suspicions of plagiarism to the editorial office.
- Verify the appropriateness of citations and references

- Please assess clarity and organization of the manuscript. We expect you to comment on efficiency of the different sections of the manuscript in conveying the research to the readers.
- Identify any language and grammatical issues in writing style. Suggest improvements for clarity, coherence, and readability.
